

Florida: District 10

The Need for Services

- 20,690 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Florida's 10th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 5 family planning clinics in Florida's 10th congressional district. 3 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 8,560 women, including 2,950 teenagers.* 84% are served by health departments, 14% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 2% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 3 of the family planning clinics in Florida's 10th congressional district are supported by Title X. 3 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Florida's 10th congressional district serve 7,210 women, including 2,520 teenagers.* 100% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 10th congressional district.*
