

Florida: District 11

The Need for Services

- 50,240 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Florida's 11th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 17 family planning clinics in Florida's 11th congressional district. 7 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 8 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 17,060 women, including 4,050 teenagers.* 70% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 24% are served by Planned Parenthood, 6% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 7 of the family planning clinics in Florida's 11th congressional district are supported by Title X. 7 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Florida's 11th congressional district serve 11,980 women, including 3,120 teenagers.* 100% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 11th congressional district.*
