



## Florida: District 12

### The Need for Services

- 33,550 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Florida's 12th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 16 family planning clinics in Florida's 12th congressional district. 10 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 4 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 13,850 women, including 3,690 teenagers.\* 75% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 18% are served by Planned Parenthood, 8% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 9 of the family planning clinics in Florida's 12th congressional district are supported by Title X. 8 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Florida's 12th congressional district serve 8,450 women, including 2,160 teenagers.\* 96% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 4% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 12th congressional district.*
