



## Florida: District 14

### The Need for Services

- 20,740 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Florida's 14th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 14 family planning clinics in Florida's 14th congressional district. 4 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 8 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.

- Together, these clinics serve 13,170 women, including 4,830 teenagers.\* 38% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 47% are served by Planned Parenthood, 16% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 4 of the family planning clinics in Florida's 14th congressional district are supported by Title X. 3 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.

- These Title X-supported clinics in Florida's 14th congressional district serve 8,330 women, including 3,760 teenagers.\* 50% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 50% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 14th congressional district.*
