



Florida: District 16

The Need for Services

- 23,080 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Florida's 16th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 17 family planning clinics in Florida's 16th congressional district. 11 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 11,930 women, including 3,700 teenagers.* 65% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 25% are served by Planned Parenthood, 9% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 12 of the family planning clinics in Florida's 16th congressional district are supported by Title X. 11 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Florida's 16th congressional district serve 10,820 women, including 3,270 teenagers.* 72% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 28% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 16th congressional district.*
