



## Florida: District 17

### The Need for Services

- 64,780 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Florida's 17th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 15 family planning clinics in Florida's 17th congressional district. 2 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 6 are run by community health centers and 4 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 13,100 women, including 4,920 teenagers.\* 31% are served by health departments, 8% are served by hospitals, 24% are served by Planned Parenthood, 17% are served by community health centers and 21% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 4 of the family planning clinics in Florida's 17th congressional district are supported by Title X. 2 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Florida's 17th congressional district serve 7,160 women, including 2,660 teenagers.\* 56% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 44% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 17th congressional district.*
