



Florida: District 18

The Need for Services

- 47,200 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Florida's 18th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 17 family planning clinics in Florida's 18th congressional district. 8 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 4 are run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 12,710 women, including 2,180 teenagers.* 39% are served by health departments, 8% are served by hospitals, 20% are served by Planned Parenthood, 16% are served by community health centers and 17% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 11 of the family planning clinics in Florida's 18th congressional district are supported by Title X. 7 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 4 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Florida's 18th congressional district serve 7,270 women, including 1,320 teenagers.* 65% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 35% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 18th congressional district.*
