

## Florida: District 23

### The Need for Services

- 58,440 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Florida's 23th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 11 family planning clinics in Florida's 23th congressional district. 7 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 12,980 women, including 3,970 teenagers.\* 90% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 9% are served by community health centers and 2% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 7 of the family planning clinics in Florida's 23th congressional district are supported by Title X. 7 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Florida's 23th congressional district serve 11,630 women, including 3,540 teenagers.\* 100% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 23th congressional district.*
