

Florida: District 25

The Need for Services

- 37,720 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Florida's 25th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 9 family planning clinics in Florida's 25th congressional district. 2 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 6 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 2,130 women, including 680 teenagers.* 34% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 9% are served by Planned Parenthood, 56% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 3 of the family planning clinics in Florida's 25th congressional district are supported by Title X. 2 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Florida's 25th congressional district serve 930 women, including 220 teenagers.* 78% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 22% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 25th congressional district.*
