

## Florida: District 3

### The Need for Services

- 60,940 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Florida's 3rd congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 26 family planning clinics in Florida's 3rd congressional district. 14 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 4 are run by Planned Parenthood, 6 are run by community health centers and 2 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 29,970 women, including 7,840 teenagers.\* 51% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 36% are served by Planned Parenthood, 10% are served by community health centers and 2% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 17 of the family planning clinics in Florida's 3rd congressional district are supported by Title X. 14 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Florida's 3rd congressional district serve 19,360 women, including 5,650 teenagers.\* 80% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 7% are served by Planned Parenthood, 13% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 3rd congressional district.*
