

Florida: District 8

The Need for Services

- 27,400 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Florida's 8th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 6 family planning clinics in Florida's 8th congressional district. 2 are run by health departments, 3 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 4,540 women, including 1,430 teenagers.* 21% are served by health departments, 69% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 10% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 3 of the family planning clinics in Florida's 8th congressional district are supported by Title X. 2 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Florida's 8th congressional district serve 1,410 women, including 430 teenagers.* 67% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 33% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 8th congressional district.*
