

## Georgia: District 2

### The Need for Services

- 60,990 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Georgia's 2nd congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 48 family planning clinics in Georgia's 2nd congressional district. 42 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 6 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 29,670 women, including 8,400 teenagers.\* 98% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 2% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 41 of the family planning clinics in Georgia's 2nd congressional district are supported by Title X. 41 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Georgia's 2nd congressional district serve 28,830 women, including 8,080 teenagers.\* 100% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 2nd congressional district.*
