

Hawaii: District 1

The Need for Services

- 27,600 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Hawaii's 1st congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 13 family planning clinics in Hawaii's 1st congressional district. 5 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 3 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 4,680 women, including 2,110 teenagers.* 32% are served by health departments, 1% are served by hospitals, 14% are served by Planned Parenthood, 40% are served by community health centers and 13% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 13 of the family planning clinics in Hawaii's 1st congressional district are supported by Title X. 5 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 3 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Hawaii's 1st congressional district serve 4,680 women, including 2,110 teenagers.* 32% are served by health departments, 1% are served by hospitals, 14% are served by Planned Parenthood, 40% are served by community health centers and 13% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 1st congressional district.*
