



Hawaii: District 2

The Need for Services

- 33,790 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Hawaii's 2nd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 20 family planning clinics in Hawaii's 2nd congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 10 are run by community health centers and 7 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 4,340 women, including 2,170 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 13% are served by hospitals, 21% are served by Planned Parenthood, 36% are served by community health centers and 30% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 20 of the family planning clinics in Hawaii's 2nd congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 10 are run by community health centers and 7 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Hawaii's 2nd congressional district serve 4,340 women, including 2,170 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 13% are served by hospitals, 21% are served by Planned Parenthood, 36% are served by community health centers and 30% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 2nd congressional district.*
