

## Idaho: District 2

### The Need for Services

- 44,950 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Idaho's 2nd congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 37 family planning clinics in Idaho's 2nd congressional district. 22 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 11 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 19,670 women, including 6,130 teenagers.\* 60% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 30% are served by Planned Parenthood, 8% are served by community health centers and 2% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 23 of the family planning clinics in Idaho's 2nd congressional district are supported by Title X. 22 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Idaho's 2nd congressional district serve 17,720 women, including 5,720 teenagers.\* 67% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 33% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 2nd congressional district.*
