

Illinois: District 12

The Need for Services

- 51,010 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Illinois's 12th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 28 family planning clinics in Illinois's 12th congressional district. 7 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 16 are run by community health centers and 3 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 14,680 women, including 4,840 teenagers.* 20% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 21% are served by Planned Parenthood, 43% are served by community health centers and 16% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 12 of the family planning clinics in Illinois's 12th congressional district are supported by Title X. 7 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 2 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Illinois's 12th congressional district serve 8,590 women, including 2,820 teenagers.* 35% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 3% are served by Planned Parenthood, 40% are served by community health centers and 22% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 12th congressional district.*
