

Illinois: District 15

The Need for Services

- 46,180 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Illinois's 15th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 11 family planning clinics in Illinois's 15th congressional district. 8 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 11,910 women, including 3,990 teenagers.* 59% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 37% are served by Planned Parenthood, 4% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 10 of the family planning clinics in Illinois's 15th congressional district are supported by Title X. 8 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Illinois's 15th congressional district serve 11,490 women, including 3,890 teenagers.* 62% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 38% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 15th congressional district.*
