

## Illinois: District 17

### The Need for Services

- 42,660 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Illinois's 17th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 20 family planning clinics in Illinois's 17th congressional district. 8 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 6 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 16,090 women, including 5,700 teenagers.\* 44% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 8% are served by Planned Parenthood, 5% are served by community health centers and 43% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 15 of the family planning clinics in Illinois's 17th congressional district are supported by Title X. 8 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 6 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Illinois's 17th congressional district serve 15,210 women, including 5,470 teenagers.\* 46% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 9% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 45% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 17th congressional district.*
