



Illinois: District 18

The Need for Services

- 29,520 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Illinois's 18th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 14 family planning clinics in Illinois's 18th congressional district. 5 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 8 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 20,350 women, including 6,840 teenagers.* 14% are served by health departments, 1% are served by hospitals, 85% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 11 of the family planning clinics in Illinois's 18th congressional district are supported by Title X. 5 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 6 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Illinois's 18th congressional district serve 18,870 women, including 6,690 teenagers.* 15% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 85% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 18th congressional district.*
