

Illinois: District 19

The Need for Services

- 29,970 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Illinois's 19th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 16 family planning clinics in Illinois's 19th congressional district. 7 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 5 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 5,020 women, including 1,940 teenagers.* 41% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 21% are served by Planned Parenthood, 8% are served by community health centers and 31% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 13 of the family planning clinics in Illinois's 19th congressional district are supported by Title X. 7 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 5 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Illinois's 19th congressional district serve 4,630 women, including 1,820 teenagers.* 44% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 22% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 33% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 19th congressional district.*
