

Illinois: District 2

The Need for Services

- 50,990 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Illinois's 2nd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 13 family planning clinics in Illinois's 2nd congressional district. 4 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 6 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 10,560 women, including 3,150 teenagers.* 55% are served by health departments, 16% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 27% are served by community health centers and 2% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 5 of the family planning clinics in Illinois's 2nd congressional district are supported by Title X. 4 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Illinois's 2nd congressional district serve 7,240 women, including 2,000 teenagers.* 81% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 19% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 2nd congressional district.*
