

Illinois: District 3

The Need for Services

- 26,850 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Illinois's 3rd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 5 family planning clinics in Illinois's 3rd congressional district. 1 is run by a health department, 2 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 3,340 women, including 1,020 teenagers.* 29% are served by health departments, 42% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 29% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 3 of the family planning clinics in Illinois's 3rd congressional district are supported by Title X. 1 is run by a health department, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Illinois's 3rd congressional district serve 1,940 women, including 460 teenagers.* 50% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 50% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 3rd congressional district.*
