

## Illinois: District 7

### The Need for Services

- 79,280 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Illinois's 7th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 38 family planning clinics in Illinois's 7th congressional district. 2 are run by health departments, 9 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 19 are run by community health centers and 5 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 40,880 women, including 8,680 teenagers.\* 3% are served by health departments, 38% are served by hospitals, 35% are served by Planned Parenthood, 13% are served by community health centers and 12% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 9 of the family planning clinics in Illinois's 7th congressional district are supported by Title X. 1 is run by a health department, 5 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Illinois's 7th congressional district serve 16,270 women, including 3,210 teenagers.\* 3% are served by health departments, 68% are served by hospitals, 17% are served by Planned Parenthood, 3% are served by community health centers and 10% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 7th congressional district.*
