

Illinois: District 9

The Need for Services

- 35,970 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Illinois's 9th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 6 family planning clinics in Illinois's 9th congressional district. 2 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 6,950 women, including 1,360 teenagers.* 31% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 57% are served by Planned Parenthood, 6% are served by community health centers and 6% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 3 of the family planning clinics in Illinois's 9th congressional district are supported by Title X. 2 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Illinois's 9th congressional district serve 2,490 women, including 470 teenagers.* 87% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 13% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 9th congressional district.*
