

Indiana: District 1

The Need for Services

- 44,710 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Indiana's 1st congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 8 family planning clinics in Indiana's 1st congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 6 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 19,660 women, including 5,400 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 3% are served by hospitals, 96% are served by Planned Parenthood, 1% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 4 of the family planning clinics in Indiana's 1st congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Indiana's 1st congressional district serve 4,040 women, including 1,010 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 13% are served by hospitals, 82% are served by Planned Parenthood, 5% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 1st congressional district.*
