



## Indiana: District 2

### The Need for Services

- 38,430 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Indiana's 2nd congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 12 family planning clinics in Indiana's 2nd congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 7 are run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 10,050 women, including 3,570 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 16% are served by hospitals, 75% are served by Planned Parenthood, 4% are served by community health centers and 5% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 5 of the family planning clinics in Indiana's 2nd congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 4 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Indiana's 2nd congressional district serve 5,470 women, including 2,120 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 14% are served by hospitals, 86% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 2nd congressional district.*
