

Indiana: District 3

The Need for Services

- 30,960 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Indiana's 3rd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 3 family planning clinics in Indiana's 3rd congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 6,840 women, including 2,220 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 85% are served by Planned Parenthood, 15% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 2 of the family planning clinics in Indiana's 3rd congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Indiana's 3rd congressional district serve 5,830 women, including 2,180 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 100% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 3rd congressional district.*
