

## Indiana: District 4

### The Need for Services

- 33,850 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Indiana's 4th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 8 family planning clinics in Indiana's 4th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 6 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 16,450 women, including 5,070 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 91% are served by Planned Parenthood, 3% are served by community health centers and 5% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 3 of the family planning clinics in Indiana's 4th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Indiana's 4th congressional district serve 3,800 women, including 1,420 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 77% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 23% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 4th congressional district.*
