

Indiana: District 7

The Need for Services

- 59,430 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Indiana's 7th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 28 family planning clinics in Indiana's 7th congressional district. 1 is run by a health department, 14 are run by hospitals, 5 are run by Planned Parenthood, 6 are run by community health centers and 2 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 33,050 women, including 8,340 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 25% are served by hospitals, 67% are served by Planned Parenthood, 4% are served by community health centers and 4% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 20 of the family planning clinics in Indiana's 7th congressional district are supported by Title X. 1 is run by a health department, 12 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 2 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Indiana's 7th congressional district serve 9,540 women, including 3,020 teenagers.* 2% are served by health departments, 74% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 10% are served by community health centers and 13% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 7th congressional district.*
