



Indiana: District 8

The Need for Services

- 42,240 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Indiana's 8th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 11 family planning clinics in Indiana's 8th congressional district. 1 is run by a health department, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 7 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 16,030 women, including 5,760 teenagers.* 3% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 62% are served by Planned Parenthood, 1% are served by community health centers and 34% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 8 of the family planning clinics in Indiana's 8th congressional district are supported by Title X. 1 is run by a health department, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 7 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Indiana's 8th congressional district serve 5,950 women, including 2,340 teenagers.* 9% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 91% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 8th congressional district.*
