

## Indiana: District 9

### The Need for Services

- 45,900 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Indiana's 9th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 15 family planning clinics in Indiana's 9th congressional district. 3 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 8 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 3 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 23,220 women, including 6,640 teenagers.\* 5% are served by health departments, 5% are served by hospitals, 82% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 8% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 5 of the family planning clinics in Indiana's 9th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 2 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Indiana's 9th congressional district serve 12,190 women, including 2,980 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 10% are served by hospitals, 79% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 11% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 9th congressional district.*
