

Iowa: District 1

The Need for Services

- 37,880 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Iowa's 1st congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 15 family planning clinics in Iowa's 1st congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 3 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 7 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 18,880 women, including 4,520 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 23% are served by hospitals, 17% are served by Planned Parenthood, 8% are served by community health centers and 52% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 10 of the family planning clinics in Iowa's 1st congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 3 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 7 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Iowa's 1st congressional district serve 14,130 women, including 3,330 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 30% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 70% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 1st congressional district.*
