

Iowa: District 2

The Need for Services

- 40,070 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Iowa's 2nd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 18 family planning clinics in Iowa's 2nd congressional district. 1 is run by a health department, 4 are run by hospitals, 7 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 5 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 18,220 women, including 5,380 teenagers.* 4% are served by health departments, 25% are served by hospitals, 55% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 16% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 13 of the family planning clinics in Iowa's 2nd congressional district are supported by Title X. 1 is run by a health department, 3 are run by hospitals, 5 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 4 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Iowa's 2nd congressional district serve 13,100 women, including 3,800 teenagers.* 6% are served by health departments, 34% are served by hospitals, 39% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 22% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 2nd congressional district.*
