

Iowa: District 3

The Need for Services

- 28,690 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Iowa's 3rd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 13 family planning clinics in Iowa's 3rd congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 6 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 6 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 10,570 women, including 2,720 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 76% are served by Planned Parenthood, 12% are served by community health centers and 13% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 12 of the family planning clinics in Iowa's 3rd congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 6 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 5 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Iowa's 3rd congressional district serve 10,530 women, including 2,710 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 76% are served by Planned Parenthood, 12% are served by community health centers and 12% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 3rd congressional district.*
