

Iowa: District 5

The Need for Services

- 28,930 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Iowa's 5th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 18 family planning clinics in Iowa's 5th congressional district. 5 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 7 are run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 2 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 11,310 women, including 4,620 teenagers.* 10% are served by health departments, 13% are served by hospitals, 67% are served by Planned Parenthood, 4% are served by community health centers and 7% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 14 of the family planning clinics in Iowa's 5th congressional district are supported by Title X. 5 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 7 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 2 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Iowa's 5th congressional district serve 9,440 women, including 3,280 teenagers.* 11% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 80% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 9% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 5th congressional district.*
