

Kansas: District 1

The Need for Services

- 40,540 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Kansas's 1st congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 52 family planning clinics in Kansas's 1st congressional district. 45 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 21,460 women, including 4,750 teenagers.* 65% are served by health departments, 1% are served by hospitals, 6% are served by Planned Parenthood, 28% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 46 of the family planning clinics in Kansas's 1st congressional district are supported by Title X. 45 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Kansas's 1st congressional district serve 15,170 women, including 4,130 teenagers.* 91% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 9% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 1st congressional district.*
