

Kansas: District 4

The Need for Services

- 37,620 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Kansas's 4th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 23 family planning clinics in Kansas's 4th congressional district. 15 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 6 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 10,880 women, including 3,380 teenagers.* 42% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 39% are served by Planned Parenthood, 13% are served by community health centers and 6% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 13 of the family planning clinics in Kansas's 4th congressional district are supported by Title X. 12 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Kansas's 4th congressional district serve 7,790 women, including 2,500 teenagers.* 45% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 55% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 4th congressional district.*
