

Kentucky: District 3

The Need for Services

- 34,150 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Kentucky's 3rd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 19 family planning clinics in Kentucky's 3rd congressional district. 14 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 16,140 women, including 4,910 teenagers.* 56% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 41% are served by Planned Parenthood, 3% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 11 of the family planning clinics in Kentucky's 3rd congressional district are supported by Title X. 10 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Kentucky's 3rd congressional district serve 10,310 women, including 2,980 teenagers.* 68% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 32% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 3rd congressional district.*
