

Kentucky: District 6

The Need for Services

- 36,950 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Kentucky's 6th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 24 family planning clinics in Kentucky's 6th congressional district. 18 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 30,290 women, including 9,210 teenagers.* 48% are served by health departments, 22% are served by hospitals, 29% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 22 of the family planning clinics in Kentucky's 6th congressional district are supported by Title X. 18 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Kentucky's 6th congressional district serve 23,650 women, including 6,560 teenagers.* 62% are served by health departments, 1% are served by hospitals, 37% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 6th congressional district.*
