

Louisiana: District 2

The Need for Services

- 62,030 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Louisiana's 2nd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 12 family planning clinics in Louisiana's 2nd congressional district. 3 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 3 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 16,950 women, including 5,900 teenagers.* 46% are served by health departments, 12% are served by hospitals, 18% are served by Planned Parenthood, 5% are served by community health centers and 19% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 8 of the family planning clinics in Louisiana's 2nd congressional district are supported by Title X. 3 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 3 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Louisiana's 2nd congressional district serve 14,330 women, including 5,080 teenagers.* 54% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 21% are served by Planned Parenthood, 2% are served by community health centers and 22% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 2nd congressional district.*
