

Louisiana: District 3

The Need for Services

- 42,800 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Louisiana's 3rd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 19 family planning clinics in Louisiana's 3rd congressional district. 12 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 4 are run by community health centers and 2 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 15,380 women, including 4,180 teenagers.* 64% are served by health departments, 10% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 10% are served by community health centers and 16% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 18 of the family planning clinics in Louisiana's 3rd congressional district are supported by Title X. 12 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 2 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Louisiana's 3rd congressional district serve 15,340 women, including 4,160 teenagers.* 64% are served by health departments, 10% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 10% are served by community health centers and 16% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 3rd congressional district.*
