



Louisiana: District 4

The Need for Services

- 43,250 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Louisiana's 4th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 19 family planning clinics in Louisiana's 4th congressional district. 13 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 4 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 9,810 women, including 2,500 teenagers.* 82% are served by health departments, 11% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 6% are served by community health centers and 1% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 14 of the family planning clinics in Louisiana's 4th congressional district are supported by Title X. 13 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Louisiana's 4th congressional district serve 8,160 women, including 1,970 teenagers.* 99% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 1% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 4th congressional district.*
