



## Louisiana: District 5

### The Need for Services

- 49,470 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Louisiana's 5th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 25 family planning clinics in Louisiana's 5th congressional district. 21 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 16,790 women, including 4,600 teenagers.\* 76% are served by health departments, 1% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 4% are served by community health centers and 19% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 24 of the family planning clinics in Louisiana's 5th congressional district are supported by Title X. 21 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Louisiana's 5th congressional district serve 16,570 women, including 4,530 teenagers.\* 76% are served by health departments, 1% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 3% are served by community health centers and 20% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 5th congressional district.*
