

## Louisiana: District 6

### The Need for Services

- 40,010 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Louisiana's 6th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 10 family planning clinics in Louisiana's 6th congressional district. 7 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 10,340 women, including 3,070 teenagers.\* 60% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 22% are served by Planned Parenthood, 18% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 9 of the family planning clinics in Louisiana's 6th congressional district are supported by Title X. 7 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Louisiana's 6th congressional district serve 10,100 women, including 3,000 teenagers.\* 61% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 23% are served by Planned Parenthood, 16% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 6th congressional district.*
