

## Louisiana: District 7

### The Need for Services

- 43,710 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Louisiana's 7th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 16 family planning clinics in Louisiana's 7th congressional district. 10 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 3 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 6,640 women, including 1,970 teenagers.\* 81% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 17% are served by community health centers and 1% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 13 of the family planning clinics in Louisiana's 7th congressional district are supported by Title X. 10 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 2 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Louisiana's 7th congressional district serve 6,570 women, including 1,930 teenagers.\* 82% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 17% are served by community health centers and 1% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 7th congressional district.*
