

## Maine: District 2

### The Need for Services

- 45,330 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Maine's 2nd congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 49 family planning clinics in Maine's 2nd congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 16 are run by community health centers and 32 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 31,940 women, including 9,480 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 5% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 15% are served by community health centers and 79% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 21 of the family planning clinics in Maine's 2nd congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 19 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Maine's 2nd congressional district serve 15,230 women, including 5,450 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 100% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 2nd congressional district.*
