

Maryland: District 3

The Need for Services

- 27,350 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Maryland's 3rd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 14 family planning clinics in Maryland's 3rd congressional district. 7 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 11,910 women, including 3,730 teenagers.* 52% are served by health departments, 12% are served by hospitals, 35% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 12 of the family planning clinics in Maryland's 3rd congressional district are supported by Title X. 7 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Maryland's 3rd congressional district serve 10,820 women, including 3,400 teenagers.* 58% are served by health departments, 4% are served by hospitals, 38% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 3rd congressional district.*
