

Maryland: District 5

The Need for Services

- 21,250 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Maryland's 5th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 10 family planning clinics in Maryland's 5th congressional district. 5 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 2 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 7,130 women, including 2,240 teenagers.* 64% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 12% are served by Planned Parenthood, 2% are served by community health centers and 22% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 6 of the family planning clinics in Maryland's 5th congressional district are supported by Title X. 5 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Maryland's 5th congressional district serve 5,430 women, including 1,600 teenagers.* 84% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 16% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 5th congressional district.*
