

Maryland: District 6

The Need for Services

- 22,820 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Maryland's 6th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 16 family planning clinics in Maryland's 6th congressional district. 13 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 10,760 women, including 3,480 teenagers.* 65% are served by health departments, 12% are served by hospitals, 21% are served by Planned Parenthood, 3% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 14 of the family planning clinics in Maryland's 6th congressional district are supported by Title X. 13 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Maryland's 6th congressional district serve 9,200 women, including 2,970 teenagers.* 76% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 24% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 6th congressional district.*
