

Maryland: District 7

The Need for Services

- 59,750 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Maryland's 7th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 27 family planning clinics in Maryland's 7th congressional district. 6 are run by health departments, 10 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 10 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 14,570 women, including 4,970 teenagers.* 41% are served by health departments, 29% are served by hospitals, 18% are served by Planned Parenthood, 13% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 12 of the family planning clinics in Maryland's 7th congressional district are supported by Title X. 6 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Maryland's 7th congressional district serve 10,060 women, including 3,300 teenagers.* 59% are served by health departments, 11% are served by hospitals, 26% are served by Planned Parenthood, 5% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 7th congressional district.*
